Explanation of Terms:

- Group 1 Literature is purely a literature course.
- Group 1 Language & Literature is a course that involves the study of both literature and language.
- Language B is for students with some foreign language background in this language e.g. ca. 2 years for SL, 3-4 years for HL.
- Mathematics HL is a math course for engineers/mathematicians.
- Mathematics SL is a math course for technical and medical subjects.
- Math Studies is math in society.
